



Keith Campbell Receives the Choose Clean Water Coalition Leadership Award

On June 4, 2013, during the Choose Clean Water Coalition's Annual Conference, more than 225 Coalition members and clean water advocates gathered at the National Aquarium in Baltimore, Maryland to recognize Keith Campbell for his leadership as a steward and advocate for the Chesapeake Bay. Tony Caligiuri, Senior Vice President of Conservation and Education at the National Wildlife Federation presented the award.

Mr. Caligiuri said during his remarks, "We all think about what we would do if we won the lottery. Well, Keith Campbell is somebody that has been financially fortunate and is actually using his money to improve the Chesapeake Bay." During his remarks, Mr. Caligiuri asked members of the audience to stand if -- their organization received money from The Campbell Foundation; they were able to do their work because of an organization that was funded by The Foundation; or their local waters are cleaner because of work done by an organization or project funded by The Campbell Foundation.
